

# Adding the CHHE grant to your Publications in MyNCBI

## Step 1: Log in to My NCBI

- 1.1. Open your web browser and go to the NCBI website (<https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/>).
- 1.2. Click on the "Log in to NCBI" link at the top right corner of the page.



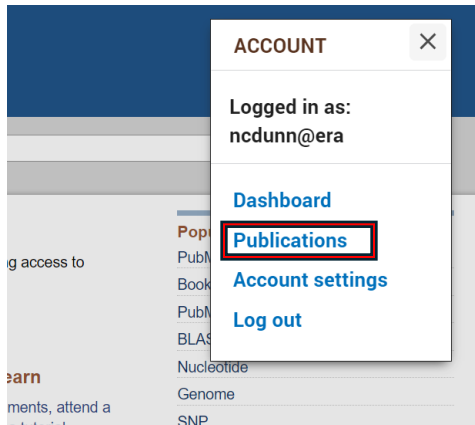
- 1.3. Enter your username and password to log in. This will likely be through ERA Commons

## Step 2: Navigate to the MyBibliography Page.

2. 1. Once logged in you will arrive on this page. Click on the profile button in the top right corner. It will show your email.

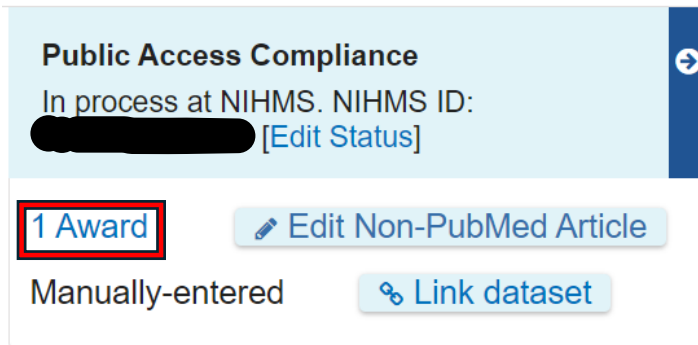
