Position Description: A staff fellow position for a regulatory review scientist is currently available in the FDA Office of Food Additive Safety (OFAS), Center for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition (CFSAN). The position requires a Ph.D. in toxicology, pharmacology, biology, or similar field with relevance to public health. In addition to the forestated qualifications, the applicant must have experience in reproductive/teratologic toxicology and metabolism.

The duties of the open regulatory reviewer position would include:

- Review and technical evaluation of regulatory and scientific issues regarding food ingredients, direct additives and indirect additives.
- Review reproductive/developmental toxicology study data (including teratology data) and metabolism data related to safety evaluation of food ingredients, direct additives, and indirect additives
- Evaluates toxicological data and information submitted to the Agency by notifiers, petitioners, or from other sources, which pertain to the safety of food ingredients and additives.
- Consults with prospective petitioners/notifiers prior to submission concerning proposed new uses of food ingredients/additives, advising on submission content and approaches to meet statutory standards. Advises interested parties of any inadequacies that may preclude requested action on submissions reviewed.
- Develops and redirects, as necessary, current policies, compliance efforts, and research dealing with food ingredient/additive issues.
- Develops and maintains information for assessment and monitoring the safety of food ingredients/additives.
- Maintaining expert knowledge in relevant toxicological, pharmacological, biochemical, pharmacokinetic, toxicokinetic, and/or other relevant scientific areas.
